

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

**Fully vaccinated:** As of Nov. 16, 2021, fully vaccinated travelers who present a negative RT-PCR or antigen SARS CoV-2 test swabbed up to 48 hours prior to arrival, along with proof of vaccination, and travel insurance for the duration of their stay, will not be required to take a COVID-19 test upon arrival in the Territory. **Unvaccinated and partially vaccinated:** As of Nov. 16, 2021, unvaccinated and partially vaccinated travelers need to submit an attestation to the <u>BVI Gateway</u> no later than 24 hours prior to their arrival, a negative PCR test swabbed 3-5 days prior to arrival, obtain quarantine provisions by the Environment Health Division (<u>http://bvimonitor.info/homequarantine</u>) prior to arrival, and then undergo an on-site RT-PCR test upon arrival at a cost of USD \$50. ## COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS FAQ

Q: What is considered fully vaccinated?

A: A fully vaccinated traveler is one who received the second dose of a two-dose World Health Organization-approved vaccine against COVID-19 no less than two weeks prior to arrival, or the only dose of a one-dose World Health Organization-approved vaccine against COVID-19 no less than two weeks prior to arrival.

Q: Do I need travel insurance to enter the BVI?

A: Yes. Your travel insurance must allow provisions for COVID-19 medical costs including hospitalization, doctor's visit and prescriptions, medical repatriation, and quarantine accommodation costs.

Q: Are there any fees I should be aware of associated with the arrival process?

A: Yes. All travelers are required to pay a USD \$10 Environmental Fee at customs. Travelers are required to pay USD \$50 for antigen testing upon arrival.

Q: What new protocols are in place on property at Saba Rock?

A: Visitors to Saba Rock must wear a facial mask in all public places on property except when eating or drinking.
